UNSC Resolution 1373 was passed by the UN on 28 September 2001 and imposed obligations on UN Member States to suppress terrorism. Sub-paragraph 1(c) of Resolution 1373 obliges Member States to:

“Freeze without delay funds and other financial assets or economic resources of persons who commit, or attempt to commit, terrorist acts or participate in or facilitate the commission of terrorist acts; of entities owned or controlled directly or indirectly by such persons; and of persons and entities acting on behalf of, or at the direction of such persons and entities, including funds derived or generated from property owned or controlled directly or indirectly by such persons and associated persons and entities.”

Unlike the 1267 process, the UN Security Council does not have a centralised list of persons and entities to which Resolution 1373 applies and has left Member States to determine for themselves who such persons and entities are. The Minister for Foreign Affairs may list a person or entity on a case-by-case basis if he is satisfied that they are associated with terrorism as described in subparagraph 1(c) of Resolution 1373 (see above)
